Under 1% of total licensed capacity = \$1,000 and limited to \$1,000 for poverty factor

1 – 3 % of total licensed capacity = \$2,000

All other councils, the percentage of the total capacity divided by 2 = capacity amount round up to thousands

60 - 82% Poverty Factor = \$3,000

40 - 59% Poverty Factor = \$2,000

20 - 39% Poverty Factor = \$1,000

It is anticipated that Council allocations will stay the same for Summer 2010, Fall 2010, and Spring 2011.
